SA Childcare Association supports ECD Centres since 2010 in all 9 provinces.

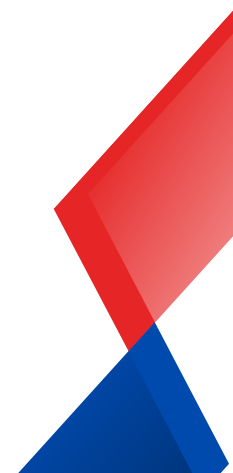

➤ Monthly Contribution Calculator

The monthly contribution is calculated as a small percentage of monthly turnover, thereby enabling all members access to the full bouquet of support benefits, irrespective of their status in the ECD sector.

How to calculate turnover?

1. Your annual turnover (income) as per accountant, divided by 12.
2. Or add all income received over 1 month from bank statement.
3. Or average month fee per child multiplied by the number of children.
